### Loose Fill Plugs

These plugs provide a uniform substrate and a structure with micro air pockets evenly distributed throughout the plug that stimulates superior fibrous root growth throughout the full plug. The substrate structure provides excellent water holding capacity while at the same time maintaining excellent drainage properties, allowing easy water management to reduce losses.

### Paperpot Plugs

Paperpots are wrapped in a non-woven mesh that is quickly and easily penetrated by roots; as soon as roots appear plants can be handled and potted. The dense rooting system especially through the sides of the plugs gives greater stability to the cutting and development of the young plant.

### Glue Plugs

Designed for easy removal without the risk of damaging precious root structures, providing excellent water retention to support early development.

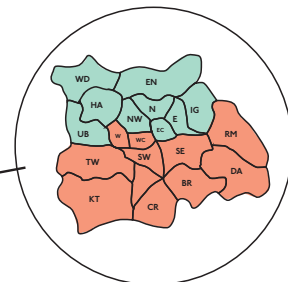
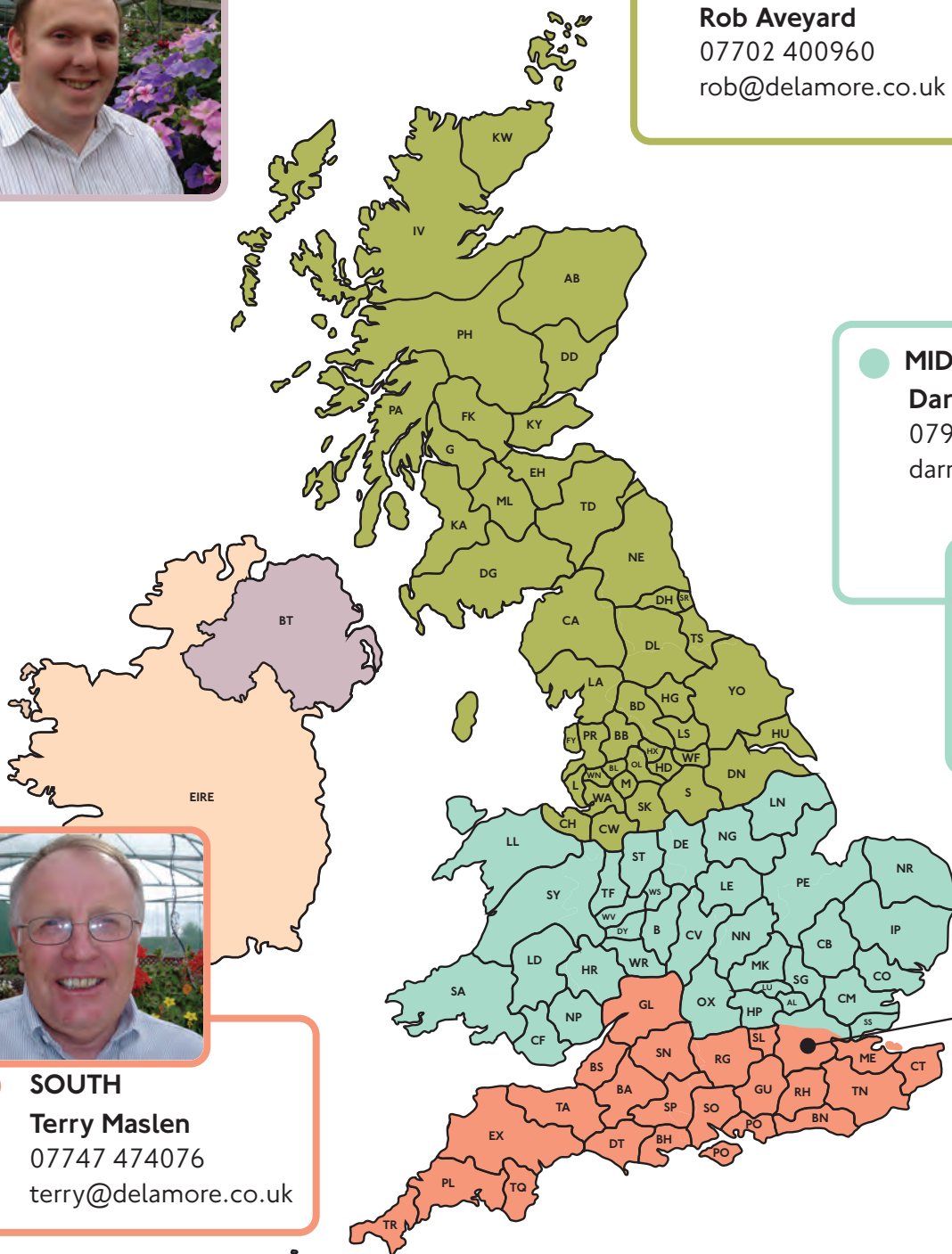

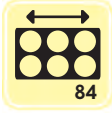
unachievable from seed. Generally speaking cutting raised production provides for a stronger more floriferous plant\*.

In the event of such plants not being available for whatever reason we reserve the right to substitute alternative varieties.
4. The property in the plants will pass to the buyer's when we deliver them to the buyer's and the plants are at the buyer's risk when the property so passes. We recommend that any damage or delay in transit should be notified to us.
5. All reasonable steps will be taken to ensure that delivery is effected at the agreed time but we cannot accept any liability for any loss arising from delayed delivery however it might be caused.
6. Should any of the plants supplied fail to comply in quantity, quality or description with the particulars of the order we shall be liable to replace the defective plants with other plants which are in all respects in accordance with the order or if such goods are not available refund the purchase money in respect of the defective plants, but we shall in no circumstances be liable in respect of any other loss incurred by the buyer as a consequence of the supply of the defective plants.
